Entry Requirements **treesystems** requirements for these courses are:

- Students must already have successfully completed the Units of Competency "HLTAID011 Provide first aid."
- Students must remain employed or self-employed in the arboriculture industry for the duration of the course.
- Students wanting to work from an Elevated Work Platform (EWP) must have completed the unit "TLILIC0005 Licence to operate a boom-type elevating work platform (boom length 11 metres or more) before commencing the course.

- The Upfront Assessment of Need (or UAN as we call it) is a process designed to help you have the best chance of success in your qualification of choice. If you want to access a qualification subsidised by the government then you'll need to complete the UAN process first.

Fee for Service: Language, Literacy & Numeracy (LLN):

- Students must complete a pre-assessment test to determine their LLN Level

Incidental expenses / cost that may be incurred by participant.
